#### Meeting of January 25th, 2022

#### **Business:**

1) The Bike Sale situation is still uncertain given renewed COVID. Keith says the options of using the Keystone or having an on-line auction are still both in play. If he and the committee choose on-line auction they would not repeat with OSullivan since we and the buyers felt the auctioneer asked too much. There are about 190 decent bikes available right now with some good choices. A decision on the type of sale must be made soon.

2) Secretary's report. Roger is moving out of town to our regret. He has served as a great secretary and we owe him much thanks. Roger indicated the hunt is on for his replacement.

3) Kar Derby. Roger reported that the Derby must stay on hold given the ongoing COVID restrictions. The City would not even give a permit if we tried to plan for one. It takes a lot of prep for a Derby in contacting sponsors and drivers and preparing for the actual setup so there is considerable lead time. At a coffee discussion we commented that with such a long hold it will be difficult to restore the momentum when the time comes that we can hold it again.

*A motion* was passed to officially cancel the Kar Derby for this year.

4) East End Playground project: The remaining tools and supplies that were auctioned off have been mostly distributed. A contractor will have to be found to complete the two shelters. There were brief comments on the financial state of the project.

5) Treasurers report. Reg gave a brief report on the current balances including where the Coupon Book finances stood. We still have a few hundred books left. I would guess that the renewed COVID restrictions have slowed things but the books are good for a year so finish moving the last of them,
